Tournament rules

1. **Day of competition** Sunday June 29 of 2025.
2. **Playground** “Pla d’Urgell” Exhibition Center
Av. del Canal 29 – Mollerussa (Lleida).
3. **Competition system** 9 rounds by Swiss System.
4. **Schedule** 8:30 – Free Breakfast
9:30 – Start of morning rounds (1st round)
16:00 – Start of afternoon rounds (6th round)
5. **Rate of play** 15 minutes with an increase of 5 seconds per move (15’ + 5’’).
6. **Catalan Gran Prix** The tournament will be valid for the XXI Catalan Grand Prix of International Open Chess Tournaments.
International Category a – Sections Category a.
7. **ELO validity** Valid for ELO FCE rapid and ELO FIDE rapid.
8. **Groups** The tournament will be played in a single group.
9. **Ranking** The ranking will be sorted in the following order: ELO FIDE rapid, ELO FIDE standard and ELO FCE rapid.
10. **Registration**
 - They can be done until Friday, June 27th at 5:00 pm by email (club@escacsmollerussa.cat). Registrations received later may participate by entering at the second round.

11. Prizes

- Prizes will be awarded at the end of the last round.
- It is mandatory to collect the prize in person; otherwise, it is understood that the prize is waived.
- The cash prizes of the general classification, by sections and specials will not be accumulative. All prizes will be subject to the corresponding withholding tax according to the current AEAT regulations. To be able to collect the prizes, it is essential to present your ID or passport.

- The prizes for sections will be done according to the ELO FCE rapid. If you do not have one, it will be used in this order: ELO FIDE rapid and ELO FIDE standard. In all 2 cases, the equivalence table between ELO FCE and ELO FIDE will be applied to assign the corresponding section for those players who do not have ELO FCE rapid.

12. Tiebreaks

- The tie-breaking system of the tournament will be Result between tied, players Buchholz -1, Median Buchholz, Absolut Buchholz , Progressive Score and Coin flip.
- For tiebreak purposes in case of non-played games FIDE adjustment will be applied.

13. Specific rules

- The waiting time is 15 minutes.
- Any player who was absent unjustifiably for a round will be considered as leaving the tournament.
- Players may only request not to be paired for a maximum of two rounds. In the round in which a player is not paired, he will get zero points. A player, in order to request not to be paired in one round, must ask the referee before the end of the previous round's session.
- The use of mobile phones in the game room is forbidden unless authorization by the refereeing team. If a mobile phone makes any noise, the referee may sanction the infraction between a warning or losing the game, depending on the circumstances.

14. Organization

- The Tournament Director will be Santos Lacasa
- The chief arbiter will be Xavier Valios.
- The decisions of the chief arbiter will be non-appealable.

15. Final Provisions

- The organization reserves the right to cancel a registration.
- Any point not provided for in these rules will be solved by the regulations of FIDE and the Catalan Chess Federation
- Players transfer their image rights to the organization for advertising the event, the results and the promotion of chess.
- Participation in the tournament implies full acceptance of these rules.
- Players will have the FCE claim forms at their disposal.
- The organization reserves the right to modify these rules.
